Sandra Lee Boody, CDA, RDH, M. Voc Ed.

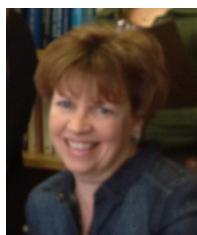

Since the beginning of her career Sandra has also worked clinically in the hospital and nursing home arena. Sandra has also been employed as a private practice clinical hygienist, a product representative, International sales team educator and product specialist. Most recently she has served as an oral care consultant training nursing staff and pharmacists in critical care settings, rehabilitation, nursing homes and hospice care. She also completed Orfacial Myology training at the University of Southern California.

Having survived the ravages of cancer she now speaks to dental/medical audiences, and support groups. Most recently she presented to the Oncology Nursing Society's Annual Session, Oncology Nursing Symposium, Diamond Pharmacy Consultants, Special Care Dentistry, West Virginia Health Care Association Annual Session, Sjogren's Syndrome, Pemphigus National Conference and MD Anderson's Cancer Center.

Lisa Morrow, PhD. Tenured Associate Professor of Psychiatry, University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine



Dr. Morrow is an internationally recognized board certified neuropsychologist and expert in brain disorders. She has conducted scientific research funded from the National Institutes of Health for over 25 years in the areas of aging, dementia, head injury, neurotoxic exposure and medical disorders. She has been an invited speaker for numerous Medical/Dental national and international organizations, and most recently was a visiting Professor at the University of L'Aquila, Italy.

She has authored over 60 peer-reviewed articles, multiple chapters, and is co-editor of the recent textbook Handbook of Medical Neuropsychology:

Applications of Cognitive Neuroscience. She has conducted hundreds of independent medical examinations and provided expert legal opinions across multiple areas of psychological and behavioral issues, including competency, guardianship, worker compensation, neurological disability, and psychiatric function.

Session Description

Changes in cognitive status can result from a myriad of diseases and health complications. Two of the most common causes of cognitive changes are head injury and dementia. Head injury and dementia are also two of the most prevalent – in the US over 1.4 million people sustain a head injury in any one year and 14% of persons over 71 meet criteria for dementia. This presentation will provide an interactive, interdisciplinary approach for dental professionals regarding cognitive and psychiatric function from young adulthood to aging adults. Course material will focus on description and treatment of brain disorders and how this relates to dental practice (e.g., compliance, polypharmacy). Case scenarios will also be presented regarding legal issues.
